The school district consists of one high school, one middle school and four elementary schools, with a total enrollment of 4,650 students, of which 390 are members of the graduating class of 2024.

Walter G. O'Connell Copiague High School is a four-year public school that was established in 1967. The population of the school is approximately 1,500 students and the average class size is 28 students. The student-to-counselor ratio is approximately 215:1. The school calendar consists of two semesters, during which there are four grading periods. All core academic courses are full-year offerings and are assigned one credit.

All candidates for graduation are ranked in numerical sequence based upon scholastic performance. The student with the highest academic average is ranked No. 1 and is designated as the valedictorian. Rank is determined at the conclusion of the student's sixth semester. All courses are included in the calculation of rank and GPA with the exception of physical education. Courses are weighted equally with the exception of courses with Honors or Advanced Placement designations. Honors courses are weighted 1.05 and Advanced Placement courses are weighted 1.15 in the calculation of rank and GPA. Final course grades shown on the transcript do not include the weighting.
